
MANGO defect guide

Correct identification Good communication Better Mangoes


This guide is to help mango handlers identify the common defects that appear during handling in the supply chain. Correct identification and good feedback through the chain will identify where improvements can be made.





Anthracnose 3a. Body anthracnose Stem end anthracnose A black rot. usually rounded and slightly sunken. Appears on the body of the fruit or around the stem. The rot does not penetrate deep into the flesh. Pink spores may be present when the rot is advanced.

Sapburn Dark brown spots and blotches, often slightly sunken. Can appear as runs or streaks down the cheek or scattered around the stem and shoulder.
